

SUMMER MUSIC PROGRAMS 2024

Drumline Camp

Led by professional music educator, Charlie Ortega, this camp is for incoming 6-9th grade students, all levels welcome! Participants will be exposed to all different types of percussion instruments that are used in large percussion ensembles, including snare, marching tenor, bass, hand percussion like conga and djembe, and the melodic percussion, such as marimba, vibraphone, and timpani. Students do not need to bring an instrument to camp. **Tuition is \$250 per student, scholarships are available.**

The camp is two weeks long, June 17-28, Monday – Friday, from 1-4pm (June 19th will be off and observed as a holiday). There will be a final camp concert on Friday June 28th for family and friends.

Summer String Camp

This camp is directed by professional music educators, Devon Nelson and Susannah Hoffman. This camp welcomes incoming 4-9th grade participants, all levels on violin, viola, cello or bass. String students will gain technical skills on their instrument, increased note reading facility, and composition instruction in a fun, supportive environment. Students need their own instrument for this camp. Please let us know if your student does not have access to one, we can assist you. **Tuition is \$250 per student. Scholarships are available.**

The camp is two weeks long, June 17-28, Monday-Friday, 9-noon (June 19th is off and observed as a holiday). There will be a final camp concert on Friday the 28th for family and friends.

Summer String Camp is held at La Colina Junior High School, 4025 Foothill Road SB 93110

Nick Rail Summer Band Camp

The camp is led by professional music educators Liz Caruso and Stephen Hughes and staffed by a host of professional musicians and educators. This camp welcomes incoming 4-9th grade students, all levels. Campers are grouped by ability and taught by professional musicians to play solo and as a group. Instruments include: trumpet, low brass (trombone/tuba), saxophone, flute, clarinet, percussion. *Please note this camp does not include guitar or piano. Students need their own instrument for this camp. Please let us know if your student does not have access to one, we can assist you.

This three-week long camp takes place June 17-July 3 (June 19th is off and observed as a holiday). Camp dates are June 17, 18, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and July 1, 2 and 3.

Tuition is \$150 per student. Scholarships are available.

Class 1 Beginning (8 a.m. to 10 a.m.) is for the complete beginner who has never ever played before. It is split into groups for flute, clarinet, sax, trumpet, trombone with specialists for each section.

Class 2 Intermediate (10a.m. to Noon) is for the beginning student who has one to two years' experience. The first hour is sectionals and the second half is concert band with Ms. Caruso and Mr. Hughes.

Class 3 Advanced (10 a.m. to Noon) is for the student with more than two years' experience. The first hour is combined concert band under the direction of Ms. Caruso and Mr. Hughes; the second hour is split into groups according to instrument type, with specialists helping each section.

Summer Band Camp is held in the Performing Arts Wing at Santa Barbara Junior High School, 721 East Cota Street SB 93101

Sound Waves Music & Movement Camp

Students will participate in singing, improvising, moving and making music in a child-centered, creative ways. Based on the Orff-Schulwerk method, this is a hands-on music learning pedagogy in which students engage with music and each other in playful, yet artful experiences. This one week camp is for incoming 1-3rd grade students and is co-directed by Liz Caruso and Sarah Gatehouse.

The camp takes place from July 8-12th from 9-noon. **Tuition is \$150 per student. Scholarships are available.**
